Kids Camp

Camp Ramah @ LimmudFest

There are many amazing counselors here to care for your children during Kids Camp and shmira (night listening) times. Outside of designated times, parents are responsible for the supervision of their children. Please see the Youth Booklet for a detailed schedule with pick-up, drop off and activity locations for all age groups. Extra copies of the schedule are available at the Help Desk.

What to Pack Each Day

- 6 months-2 year olds: Stroller (if applicable), diaper bags, diapers (plus storage bag for cloth diapers if applicable), spare clothes, hat and any comfort items (blankets, pacifiers, toys, etc.).
- Ages 3 and up: Backpack, sunscreen, water bottle, hat, bathing suit, towel and change of clothes. All campers should wear closed-toe shoes during Camp times.

6 months-Kindergarten

- Campers will be divided into two aidot (age units): 2 and under and Pre-K-Kindergarten.
- Campers must be potty trained to be in the Pre-K-Kindergarten age group.
- For safety reasons, pick-up and drop off must be done by a child's parent/guardian.

1st Grade-6th Grade

- Campers will be split into two aidot (age units): 1st-3rd Grade and 4th-6th Grade.
- Campers in 3rd grade and under must be dropped off and picked up by a parent/guardian.
- If you have a 4th grader or older and would like them to be checked in and out of camp by a parent, please tell their counselors.
- Campers in 4th grade and up that are checking themselves in and out of Kids Camp must arrive at the activity start time and cannot join or leave in the middle of that specific activity.

7th Grade & Up

- See schedule for recommended activities.

Shmira (Night Listening)

We are happy to provide complimentary shmira for families staying in cabins and hotels. During shmira hours a counselor is assigned to sit in your cabin's common room or hotel's hallway. Counselors will be present to listen for children who wake up or assist if a special need arises. If a parent is needed, the counselor will be in touch with a Ramah Darom staff person at the adult evening program.

Shmira takes place at the following times:

- Friday, August 30 | 9:15-11:15pm
- Saturday, August 31 | 9:15-11:15pm
- Sunday, September 1 | 9:15-11:15pm

In/Out Signs: Your door handle has a hanging sign on it that says "In" on one side and "Out" on the other.

Every evening, please:

1. Hang your door sign to read "In" if the adults are staying in for the night and you do NOT need shmira.
2. Hang your door sign to read "Out" if the adults are going out and you do need shmira.
3. Check in with shmira! Go into your hallway and chat with the counselor assigned to your location at the start time of shmira. Make note of where they are sitting and share your plans for the evening!

Please note:

- Families do NOT have their own individual counselor or night listener.
- Counselors are there to respond to needs that arise, not to supervise bedtime.
- If a counselor must go to the bathroom during their shmira shift, they will not leave the building they are assigned to and will leave a note where they were sitting to indicate why they are not in a visible location for that short window of time.
- Counselors on shmira will use one of the bathrooms in the hotel hallways or cabins.

Shmira is not responsible for:

- Putting children to bed.
- Entertaining or playing with children.
- Overseeing bedtime rituals.
